# Addendum IV Conservation Equivalency



- “Amendment 6 allows for states to submit alternative regulations that are **conservationally-equivalent** to regulations approved in [Addendum IV] for Board review and approval.”
- “Any jurisdiction submitting a proposal for conservation equivalency **must demonstrate through quantitative analysis** that its proposal achieves the required reduction in harvest.”
  - 25% for coastal fisheries, 20.5% for Chesapeake Bay fisheries
  - Proposals are subject to TC and LEC review for Board consideration
  - TC Criteria for Addendum IV CE proposals (M14-110)

# Maryland Proposal



- Coastal fishery (Jan 1– Dec 31):
  - **2 fish at 28-38” slot or  $\geq 44$ ”**
- Adopted from Delaware’s regulations
- Not yet approved for use in Maryland

# PRFC Proposal



- Same as Maryland's proposal for the Chesapeake Bay fisheries
  - summer/fall and trophy
- Requested TC approval to match whatever regulations MD implements for those fisheries

# TC Comments



- All but one option had been previously reviewed and approved by the TC
- TC is comfortable with MD's justification for adopting DE's regulations for their coastal fishery
- The TC approved both MD's proposal and PRFC's request with consensus

# LEC Comments



- Supports these CE proposals that would provide consistent regulations among jurisdictional areas of MD, DE, and PRFC
  - ASMFC Enforceability Guidelines, 2015
- LEC recommends that states review and clarify fish measurement procedures for consistency
