

## Commercial Landings



- ➤ 6.4 million pounds (~839,000 fish) landed in 2012
- > 2% less than 2011






## Recreational Landings




- ➤ 1.49 million fish harvested in 2012
- ➤ 5.37 million fish released alive in 2012
  - Assumed 9%
    release mortality =
    483,000 fish killed
- Removals 30% lower than 2011








### Adult Indices – FI















# Adult Indices - FD









#### JAI Review




- ➤ Recruitment failure = index falling below the trigger value for three successive years
- Trigger value = 25<sup>th</sup> percentile (Q1) of the index over a set period of time
- ➤ Recruitment failure not triggered for any indices reviewed



### JAI Review: ME



- ➤ 2012: slightly above average
- ➤ Below Q1 in 2010, above in 2011 & 2012






#### JAI Review: NY & NJ



- >2012 below Q1 point for both NY & NJ
- ➤ NY also below in 2011







### JAI Review: MD & VA



- >2012 below Q1 point for both MD & VA
- ➤ 2011 and 2010 above Q1












## ➤ 2010-2012 all above Q1





## Next Steps for Assessment



- ➤ SARC 57 workshop: July 22-26, 2013
- > Final report expected mid-September
- ➤ New F reference points proposed to be consistent with current SSB reference points
- ➤ Overall, it seemed to be acceptable for management use
- ➤ Until we get the written reports from the SARC panel, we won't know exactly what they accepted or rejected



## Next Steps for Assessment



- ➤ Model was run with preliminary 2012 data
- Finalized data are now available and the model will be updated with those data prior to October Board meeting

# Postponed Addendum Background


- ➤ At its March 2011 meeting, Board instructed PDT to draft an addendum
- Reduce striped bass fishing mortality up to 40%
- Include measures that further protect spawning stock when concentrated and vulnerable





## Postponed Draft Addendum

- ➤ Drafted by the PDT for the August 2011 meeting
- Explored status quo and three reduced fishing mortality alternatives
- > Proposed commercial management options
  - Changes to minimum size limit
  - Reduction to the commercial quota
  - Season closures
  - Additional spawning stock protection





## Postponed Draft Addendum

- > Proposed recreational management options
  - Changes to size limit
  - Changes to bag limit
  - Season closures
  - Chesapeake Bay spring trophy fishery
  - Spawning stock protection





# Draft Addendum Postponed

- At its August 2011 meeting, the Board postponed draft for public comment until November 2011 when the results from a stock assessment update were available
- ➤ At its November 2011 meeting, the Board postponed further action until completion of the next benchmark stock assessment in 2013
- As a result, the addendum did not go out for public comment.



# Action Timelines Moving Forward

- ➤ Peer-review report available in mid-September.
- In preparation to respond to results:
- 1. Initiate draft addendum at this meeting
  - Draft for public comment for October 2013 meeting
  - Conduct public hearings over the winter
  - Final Action taken at the February 2014 meeting
- 2. Initiate draft addendum at October 2013 meeting
  - Draft for public comment for February 2014 meeting
  - Public hearings conducted in Spring 2014
  - Final Action taken at the May 2014 meeting
